Pursuant to the Twenty-Nine Palms Band of Mission Indians' Service Animal Ordinance, a service animal is defined to be a dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of a person with a disability. Other species of animals will not be granted a Service Animal Permit. A Service Animal Permit is only for the use of the Service Animal Handler and Service Animal named in this Permit Application Form.
